1st Self Auricula, by Mr. Archdale, with Redman's Metropolitan; 2d, by Mr. Cooper, with Wetherhall's Blue Self; 3d, by Mr. Stead, with Arquis's Triumphalis.

1st and 3d Polyanthus, by Mr. Pickersgill, with Stead's Telegraph and Hickerley's "Black and Gold"; 2d, by Mr. Archdale, with Baily's Duncan; 4th, by Mr. Sykes, with Fillingham's Tantaroo.

The flowers were more numerous and in a better state than could be expected, considering the lateness of the season.
